Please be aware that we will be offering a **breakfast program** at Truman School beginning Monday, September 10, 2007. The price for breakfast is \$1.60 for paying students, \$.30 for those on reduced lunch, and free for those in the free lunch program.

In addition, breakfast provides youngsters with the energy needed to keep them alert in class which leads to better learning and higher grades.
