Dear Parents and Guardians:

Once again, I need to bring to your attention a serious and potentially dangerous situation that has developed in our parking lot. I would like to remind everyone of the following parking lot rules and procedures. Everyone must adhere to these procedures to ensure a safe environment for our students.

In the morning, you may: A. **DROP OFF** - students may be dropped off anywhere along the side curb or fence line (*Parent may not exit the car*)

OR

B. **PARK** - you may park your vehicle in any available parking space in the visitor's parking lot if you must exit the car to escort your child to the building.

PARKING IS NOT PERMITTED IN THE DROP-OFF AREA ALONG THE SIDE CURB OR THE FENCE LINE IN THE A.M. OR P.M.

No one is permitted to pull into the bus loop before 8:45 a.m. After that time, once school is in session, you may enter the bus loop, but be reminded that your child is late as of 8:45 AM.

Please keep in mind that when a driver exits a car that is parked inappropriately in a drop-off zone, traffic is delayed and other students are at risk of being late.

In the afternoon, parents **must** park in the visitor's parking lot when picking students up from school. Parking is not permitted along the side curb or fence line. These areas must be free to allow traffic to flow. Parking in these restricted areas creates a hazard for pedestrians leaving the playground. In addition, please do not expect your child to meet you at your car. I cannot permit any child to walk through the parking lot unless accompanied by a parent.
